FAQ

Welcome to FSBLA! Our goal is to provide Top Swimming Training at the Premier Facility in Bangkok at a reasonable price.

Is the pool completely indoor? – YES - indoor, heated, 25m x 6 lane pool will give your children the ability to train year-round in comfortable surroundings with student only changing rooms. It is not a public facility.

What do you specialize in? – FSBLA specializes in Upper Level Learn-To-Swim (Development Groups) as well as Competitive Training for First-Timers & up to Senior National Level swimmers. The 2 lower-level competitive groups will have 4 opportunities to train each week while the top-4 Upper-Level groups have the opportunity to swim 6 times per week.

What if my child is not yet at the Red Development level?

Please join the Learn-To-Swim program provided through LETS ASIA & learn to swim in a fun and enjoyable way to reach the level needed to move into FSBLA. All levels of instruction in 1 location!

Is FSBLA's pricing structure fair?

Yes FSBLA aims to be: Affordable and offers top swimmers the opportunity to increase their training to 6 times per week for the price of 3.

What if my child misses a class, is there any make-up classes?

Yes, if your child swims 1 or 2 times per week, then of course, you can make up any class you missed, this must be completed before the end of the term. If your child is swimming 3 or more times then you can already swim all week.

Do you run CLUB MEETS for the FSBLA swimmers?

Yes FSBLA runs its own Club Meets with Great Awards and will be inviting more competitive clubs and even put on our own multi-club/school meets in the future.

Can my swimmer swim with FSBLA if their school swim team is not competing in a particular event?

Yes – you child can choose to swim with FSBLA or their School club. If we are both attending an event – the swimmers usually swim with their school team, if not then the swimmer would swim with FSBLA.

We hope that you will find the facilities, coaching, friendly atmosphere and competitive pricing to your liking and hope you will join us.

Where to park and how to leave the campus?

You can park on the **Soi 31 LETS ASIA** entrance side or the FSB school entrance on soi 39 which ever you prefer. Parking on the Kindergarten/LETS ASIA side means you can exit to Sukhumvit and towards Asoke.

While **FSB parking lot you must exit onto Soi 39** and up towards Phetchaburi and you can come down to Soi 39 towards Sukhumvit and soi 49.

Do you have transportation to the school?

Yes - there is a Tuk Tuk which runs up & down Soi 31, between FSB & RSU building on the corner of Sukhumvit and soi 31.
